

Terms of use and reproduction regulations

(1) All charges are in Euro, to be paid in advance. All bank charges to be borne by the customer. We do not accept cheques.

(2) There is no claim to the reproduction of our image material. However, we do give our best to provide the requested images – given all the technical, conservatory and copy right requirements.

(3) For each publication of our image material you need the permission of Aachen Cathedral Treasury. The reproduction permit is valid for individual one-time use with concrete purpose. If you wish to publish our material in an interlinked document or re-use the image, it is compulsory to request another reproduction permit.

(4) Any transfer of the image material or the rights of use to third parties is prohibited. Reproduction rights are not transferable to another person/ organization.

(5) The publication permission expires after two years automatically.

(6) The caption must appear directly under the reproduction, on the page facing, on the reverse, in a list of illustrations, and/ or in an appendix. The credit line will include all of the information listed with each text as described in the permission agreement.

(7) You may not modify the authorized image(s). Each image must be reproduced in its entirety without cropping, bleeding, alteration, splitting, or other modification. If a detail is shown, the caption must include the word "detail".

(8) Digital images must be destroyed upon the publication of the project, latest one month after the publication.

(9) From each publication with our graphic material you are expected to send one specimencopy free of charge. You may send the copy in PDF format via e-mail.

(10) In case your publication can be of interest as an advertisement for Aachen Cathedral Treasury we might not charge for reproduction rights.

(11) Charges for new photographies are to be borne by the customer.

The place of jurisdiction is Aachen. German law applies to deliveries abroad.
